Cognitive Coaching: Reflective Conversations

Cognitive coaching gives teachers a whole new perspective. It's like pulling back the camera lens and viewing the whole scenery. The goal as a teacher, mentor or coach is the development of self-efficacy. We want to move teachers toward revising their own instruction based on self-reflection and analysis. Cognitive coaches use questioning to help teachers assess the outcomes of the learning and monitor student engagement to see the relationship between student achievement and teacher decision making.
